

SHOW OFFICE RULES & POINT PROCEDURES

1. All Cattle fees to be prepaid and reserved by pre entry deadline, with no refund after deadline.
2. Post entry on Cattle will be based on availability.
3. No refund on dropped classes, without management approval.
4. 3 calls will be made to call contestant for a class, then they will be considered a scratch
5. No refund on class fees for scratch
6. High point Overall Champions for each show and Division will be figured with a point system (explained under # 10) under each Judge and then totaled for that show.
 - a. **Conformation, Color, In Hand Trail, and Ranch Sorting do not count towards high points**
7. You must be an OFQHC member to be eligible for Yr. end awards
8. You must be an NFQHA member to be eligible for National points
9. Your horse must be Certified NFQHA, and the current owner a member of NFQHA to earn National Points
10. NFQHA Year end points will be figured on NFQHA points earned in NFQHA classes.
Regional show is double pointed for NFQHA, and for OFQHC yr end.
Credits for Category and event high points will be per the following system
Each entry earns 1 point for each horse placing under them. (Up to a maximum of 20 points per class).

Versatility placings for overall show awards

Versatility competition with 3 or more entries are placed under each judge.

1st = 6 , 2nd = 5 3rd = 4, etc... These added values determine the over all winner in multi judged shows
If only 2 horses are competing the first place horse is given a credit of 1 for OFQHC yr end

No yr end credit will be given to one horse in versatility

There must be at least 3 horses competing in your division of Versatility, in order for the major awards to be presented.. Not 3 horses per show, but 3 different horses overall for the season. No cash will be offered in lieu of awards.

If only 2 horses are competing in a Versatility event, there are no National points, but you still earn your credits for OFQHC yr end

Ties

Versatility ties are broken by NFQHA rules page 48 #9

All Classes will follow NFQHA Rules.

In Hand Trail,, Trail, and roping/daubing ties are broken by time- This will include any year end ties for OFQHC in these events.

Special award Programs

Rookie of the year, Sr. Select, All Breed high point & Super Reined cow horse will earn yr end points based on 1 point for every horse placing under them. See OFQHC web site for complete rules.

We offer All Breed High point yr end award buckle to any OFQHC member in good standing .Points will not be retroactive if you are not a member at your first competition.

Check policy

All returned checks will be charged a \$ 25 NSF Fee and the \$ 10 billing Fee. NSF checks are to be paid with cash or money order within 30 days of notification. Non payment will suspend eligibility for future shows until all fees paid. All points will be suspended until all fees are paid.

If you are competing on a NFQHA Certified horse, you as the rider, handler must be a current member of NFQHA as well. Please send copies of Horses NFQHA certificate and your NFQHA memberships with your pre-entry, or post enter with all required documents. No exceptions will be made to this rule.

No NFQHA membership card means no entry into NFQHA events.
